- Nearly 40% of AFRL's new hires in Rome, NY, over the past two years came from GI's internship programs, a testament to her commitment to building a pipeline of next-generation innovators.
- GI's HUSTLE Defense Accelerator welcomed 20 new startups and three Innovare residents: all focused on advancing mission-critical technologies.
- Strategic partnerships expanded with academic institutions and defense organizations to ensure alignment with Department of Defense priorities, reinforcing Griffiss Institute's role as a trusted convener for innovation, talent development, and technology transition.



Hage's leadership emphasizes not just growth but also the well-being of people. Her dedication to nurturing talent, especially in response to the increasing demand for a skilled STEM workforce, changes lives and shapes the next generation of innovators.
